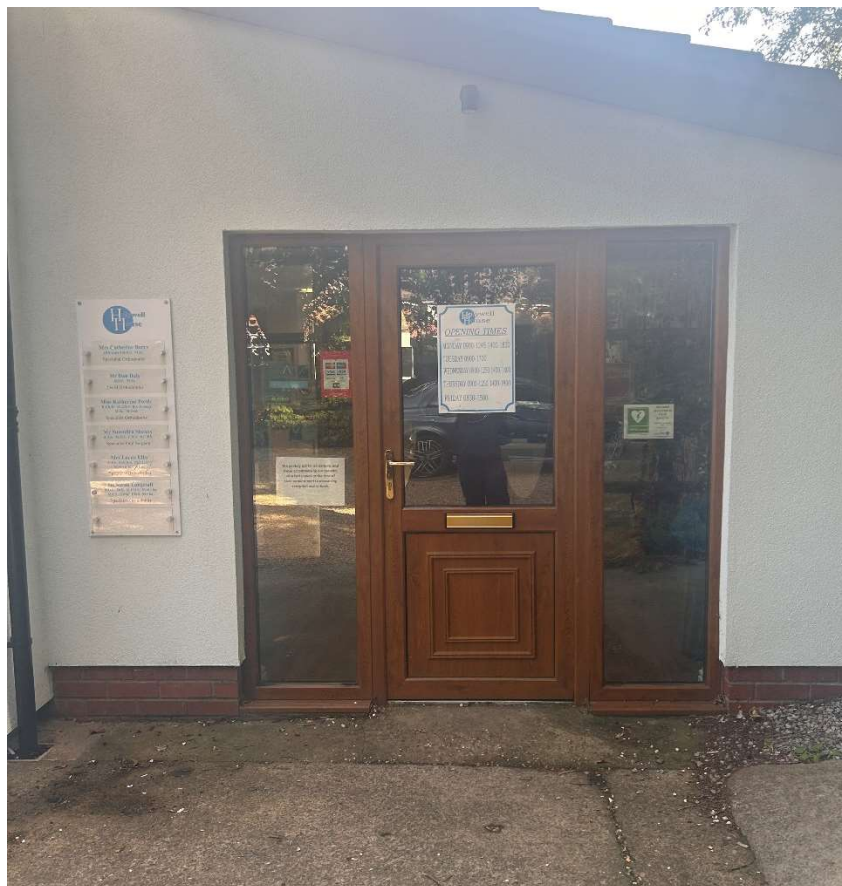

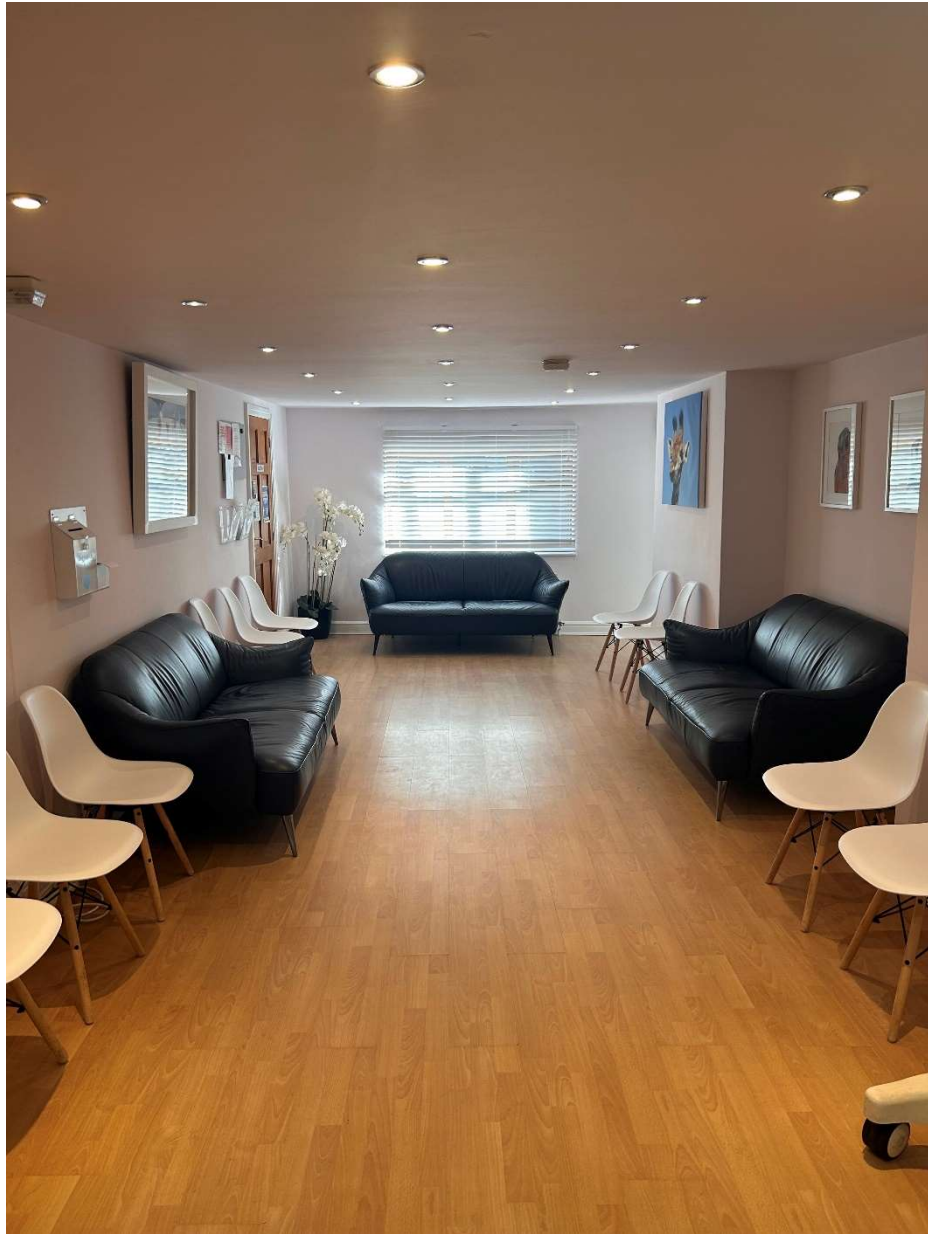
This is our reception area....





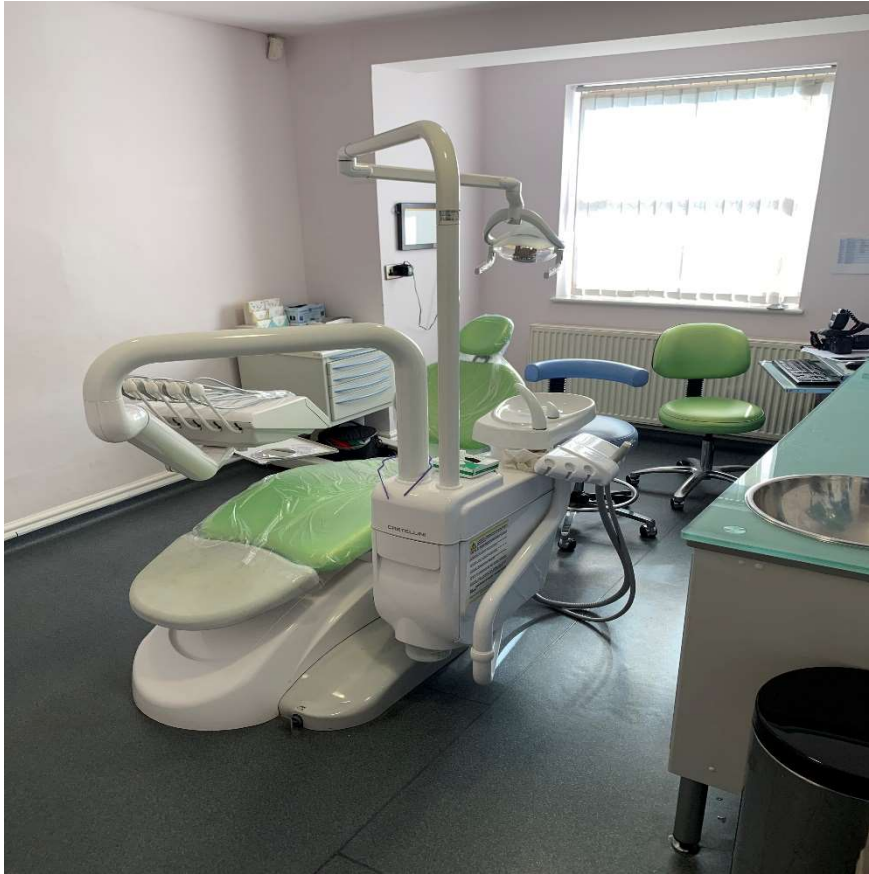
This is our downstairs waiting area....

They will use a little mirror to look into your mouth.

There will be a smiling Orthodontist and Dental Nurse with you.

There will be mouthwash for you to rinse your teeth, or you can use plain water if you prefer.

The orthodontist will wear gloves and over their mouth they will wear a mask.

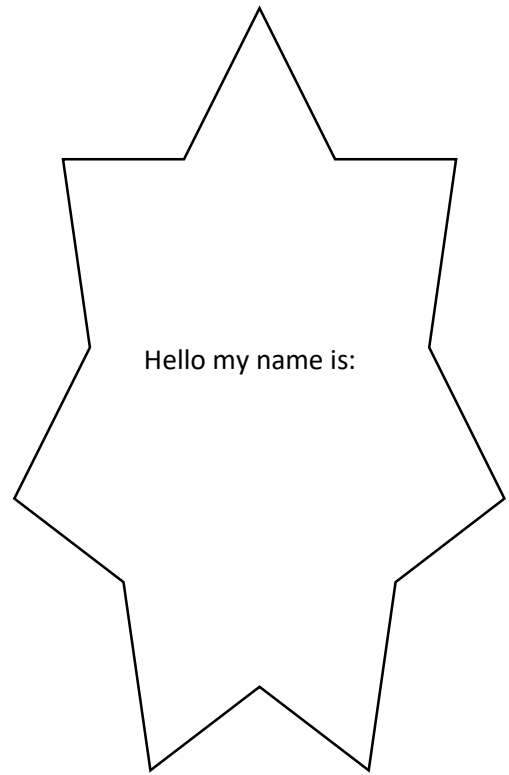
