


This is our reception area....




You will come here to check in for your appointment.

You will also return here to book any further appointments to see your dentist. For Orthodontic appointments we will email your next appointment out to you.


You will be greeted by friendly smiling faces.

There will be mouthwash for you to rinse your teeth, or you can use plain water if you prefer.


The Orthodontist/Dentist will wear gloves and over their mouth they will wear a mask.
